


#### Lelaine De La Cruz (Fleur)

#### Director – Rose Goldthorp




Rose Goldthorp has been making films for nine years, now. She has already released two features. These are: two featurettes of ¾ hour each (one is a sci-fi: "Watcher" and the other is an Edwardian rom-com: "Silverville"), and another full feature: "A Ghost in Corsets". Both features are set in New Zealand and have been entered for the NZIFF and other festivals. Rose is now

releasing her third feature, "Fleur's Secret", to festivals, Jan. '19, onwards.

Rose has also made over fifteen short films and is busy at the moment, in post production on her fourth feature "The Rocky Road to Freedom".

Rose is also co-writing, at the moment, an adaptation of 19th century novel. Rose has also written several other feature scripts, but these have not been accepted by the commission for development funding. She is also preparing a web-show for release in 2020.

Rose is also fully fluent in French and is in her last year of a Communications degree, at Auckland University (www.rosegoldthorp.com).

#### > What is your role on AGIC?

Writer / Director / Editor / Production Manager

## > Why do you make films?

I never really started 'making films': I just never stopped playing. I started writing down my little plays and then, when I was eleven, and my dad got a Handicam, I just took it over and started filming my plays, and people kept playing along as I got older.

## > What was the hardest thing about making this film?

Getting the church and the choir and the audience, as well as the cast and crew, all together in one place at one time, to shoot the concert scenes, where Fleur sings, for the first time, on stage..

## > Will you make films as a career after university?

Well, I have set up my own production company to do this, but I don't know how soon production start-ups become solvent ..... it'll probably take years

## > How old were you when you made this film?

I wrote it aged 16, revised it at 17, shot it and co-edited it when I was 19. A guy in LA kindly did the colour-grading for me in return for profit-share and credits.

## > Will you go to L.A. to seek Writer / Director contracts?

No, I want to make my own films. Contracts would be very valuable learning experiences, so I would not say 'no', but that is not the direction in which I want to go, long term.

#### > What do you like about film making?

The camaraderie on set, and then watching the film come together.

## > What do you least like about film making?

List-making and emailing ... Oh, and re-writes.
